INTERNATIONAL NAVAL CONTEST 2011



THE INTERNATIONAL NAVAL CONTEST (INC) TAKES PLACE EVERY YEAR ON THE SECOND WEEKEND OF DECEMBER.

In **2011** the **INORC** (Italian Naval Old Rhythmers Club) will be the organizing Club.

When: from 10th December 2011 at 16:00 UTC to 11th December 2011 at 15:59 UTC

Bands: 3.5 - 7 - 14 - 21 - 28 MHz **Modes:** CW - SSB - Mixed

Contest Exchange:

- Naval Club Member: RST + Club ID + membership number (eg. "599 IN471")

- Non Naval Member: RST + Serial number (eg. "599 001")

Points: - QSO with Naval Club Members: 10 Points

- QSO with Non Naval Members: 1 Point

Each station may be contacted only once per band, irrespective of the mode.

Multipliers: Every different worked (or logged, for SWL) member of a Naval Club, counted only once (not again on new bands or modes).

Note: Participation in the contest is only allowed as a member of **one** club: do not use different club membership numbers.

Score: Total QSO points x Total Multipliers = Total Score

Classes:

A = Naval, All bands, mixed (single op)

B = Naval, All bands, CW (single op)

C = Naval, All bands, SSB (single op)

D = All Bands/modes SWL

E = Naval, All bands/modes, "Club Stations"

F = Non Naval, all bands/modes (single op).

Trophys: Engraved Plaque to the winner of each class. **Awards:** A Special Award will be presented to the second and third place stations of each class. Certificates of participation will be sent, via e-mail, to all participants.

Logs:

send your logs via e-mail to the Contest Manager to sandro_izale@alice.it . You will receive confirmation of log receipt. Any format and any software can be used, all are welcome, even if "Cabrillo" format is preferred. A "FAIR PLAY STATEMENT" should be included, stating that contest rules and general amateur rules have been respected during operation.

The "filename" must include your call sign. The class of participation must be indicated in the file-name or inside the file. If one or both these data are missing the log will be used as Control Log.

The "SD" by EI5DI supports the International Naval Contest (correct from version 15.35) . With previous versions of SD (downloadable free at www.rsgbcc.org/hf/sd.shtml), or with "QARTest" (free), you can use the INORC Contest which scores exactly like the I.N.C.
